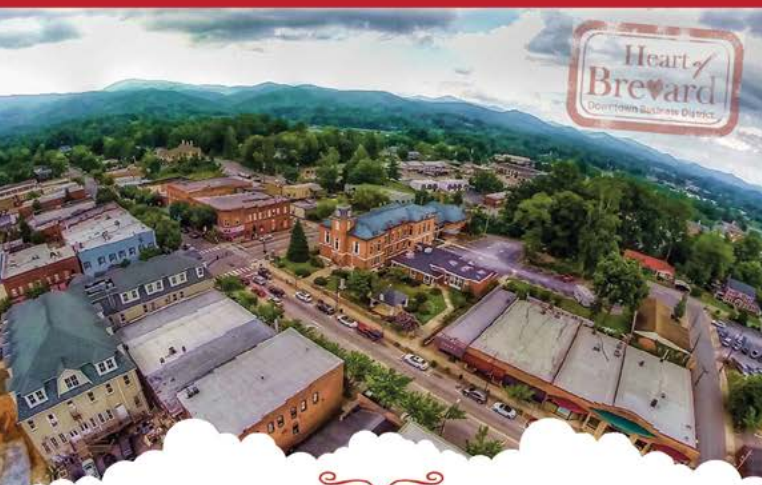

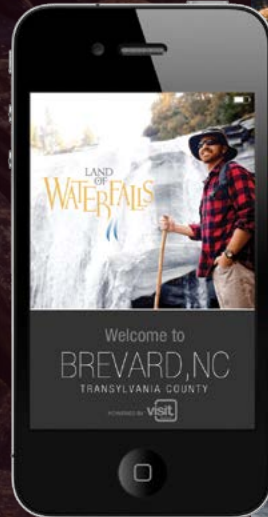

OUTDOORS



Over forty percent of the land in Transylvania is publicly owned and protected, ensuring that you'll have the chance to enjoy some of the Southeast's most extraordinary natural landscapes. There's no better base camp for your outdoor adventure.

PISGAH NATIONAL FOREST

Encompassing over 88,000 acres in Transylvania County, Pisgah National Forest serves as the gateway for outdoor adventurers of every stripe. Don't miss such memorable destinations as Looking Glass Rock, Looking Glass Falls and Sliding Rock.

DUPONT STATE RECREATIONAL FOREST

Spanning over 10,000 acres of rolling hills and rocky crags, DuPont is home to some of Transylvania County's most exciting climbing, biking and hiking opportunities. DuPont also features such dramatic waterfalls as High Falls, Triple Falls and Bridal Veil Falls.

GORGES STATE PARK

Straddling the high ledges of the Jocassee Gorge, this lush park is actually a temperate rain forest that supports an impressive roster of rare plant and animal species. Recent improvements have made Gorges more accessible, making it easier for visitors to explore its breathtaking waterfalls and dramatic topography.

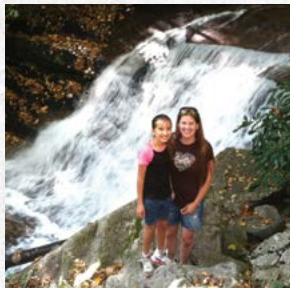
CAMPING

FISHING

Brooks. Browns. Rainbows. Small-mouthed Bass. Musky. You don't have to be a zoologist to admire the fish swimming through our lakes, rivers and streams, but you'll need a rod to catch one. 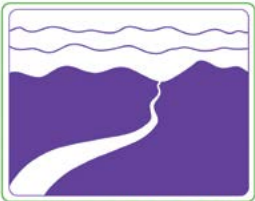
SCULPTURE WALK

Transylvania County's history includes Native Americans, pioneering settlers, and some of the great visionaries of the Gilded Age. The county's historical sites and museums attest to the indelible imprint these men and women made upon the heart, soul and spirit of the community.

TRANSYLVANIA HERITAGE MUSEUM

This fascinating museum works to preserve the historical heritage of Transylvania County and its families through educational programs, collections of artifacts, and heritage/cultural activities.

CRADLE OF FORESTRY

Walk down lush forest trails to historic cabins, climb aboard a real logging train and, at the Forest Discovery Center, explore hands-on exhibits and films that show how America's first forestry school shaped the modern forest conservation movement.

THE ALLISON-DEAVER HOUSE

The historic Allison-Deaver House provides visitors a rare glimpse into 19th century life in Transylvania. Its grounds and gardens offer picnic spots and event spaces throughout the year.

THE SILVERMONT MANSION

Completed in 1917, this gracious 33-room Greek Revival mansion offers eight acres of recreational opportunities, popular Thursday night bluegrass jams and a free museum.

PISGAH ASTRONOMICAL RESEARCH INSTITUTE

P.A.R.I. is located at the site of a former satellite tracking station operated by NASA. Today, it remains focused on the heavens — but with an emphasis on education. Evenings at P.A.R.I. are held every second Friday of each month for visitors to gaze at the night sky through optical telescopes, and scheduled tours take place every Wednesday afternoon at 2pm.

Located in Pisgah National Forest, the center offers a fascinating look at how wildlife and the natural environment relate to human events and activities. The center's exhibits include wildlife conservation areas and aquariums containing regional aquatic species. The Center also offers a wide variety of workshops and programs throughout the year.

BOBBY N. SETZER STATE FISH HATCHERY

The state's largest trout hatchery is right next door to the Pisgah Center for Wildlife Education and gives visitors a chance to see how brook, brown and rainbow are transformed from "fingerlings" to a fly fishermen's obsession. A fun and educational stop for all ages.

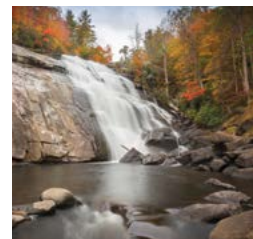
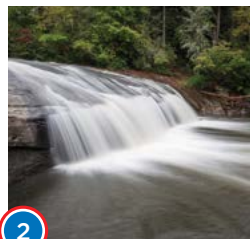
Upper Whitewater Falls *



From the intersection of US 276 and US 64 in downtown Brevard (corner of Main and Broad) go west on US 64 for 18.5 miles. Turn left onto NC 281 and travel south for 8.5 miles to parking area on your left. This is a fee area and handicap accessible for viewing of the falls. An easy .5 mile roundtrip.

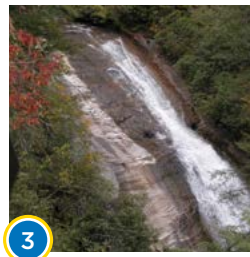


Turtleback and Rainbow Falls



From the intersection of US 276 and US 64 in downtown Brevard (corner of Main and Broad), travel US 64 west for 18.5 miles. Turn left onto NC 281 and travel south for 1 mile. Turn left into Gorges State Park entrance and follow the main road for approximately 2 miles to the last parking area, Grassy Ridge trailhead. Three kiosks and picnic tables mark the trailhead. Follow orange blazes to both waterfalls. Rainbow Falls is 1.5 miles from the trailhead and Turtleback Falls is another .25 mile further. This hike is challenging (3.5 miles, round trip) but well worth it.

Upper Bearwallow Falls



From the intersection of US 276 and US 64 in downtown Brevard (corner of Main and Broad), travel west on US 64 for 18.5 miles. Turn left onto NC 281 and travel south for 1 mile. Turn left into Gorges State Park entrance and follow road for 1 mile to Visitor Center area and turn left. Follow road .9 mile to second picnic area on the right for the Upper Bearwallow trailhead. This is a moderate one mile roundtrip hike with comfortable benches along the way.



WATERFALLS VIA NC215

French Broad / Mill Shoals / Bird Rock Falls

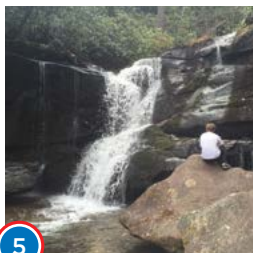
From the intersection of US 276 and US 64 (corner of Main and Broad) in downtown Brevard, travel US 64 West for 8.9 miles. Turn right on US 215 for 7.7 miles. Park on shoulder on the opposite side of the road, next to guard rail. Viewing area for French Broad and Mill Shoals Falls is a very short hike down from road, next to old red mill house. Follow trail down river approximately .3 miles to see Bird Rock Falls. Scenic, moderate .6 mile roundtrip. These

waterfalls are on private property. Living Waters very generously allows visitors.

WATERFALLS IN PISGAH FOREST VIA US276

From Pisgah Ranger Station follow US Hwy. 276 North

Cedar Rock Falls

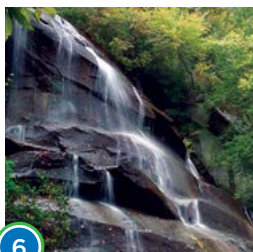

From the intersection of US 276, NC 280 and US 64 in Pisgah Forest head north on US 276 for 5.3 miles and bear left on FS 475 for 1.4 miles. Turn left into the Pisgah Center for Wildlife Education parking area. Hike logging road FS 475C (near building and behind a gate) a few feet and turn right on Cat Gap Loop trail. Hike approximately .75 mile to unmarked trail on left leading down to falls. Follow unmarked trail for

approximately .3 mile to the base of falls. Challenging hike of two miles roundtrip.

Daniel Ridge Falls (aka Tom Spring Falls and Jackson Falls)

From the intersection of US 276, NC 280 and US 64 in Pisgah Forest head north on US 276 for 5.3 miles, bear left on FS 475 for 3.9 miles to an unmarked parking area on the right. Hike behind gate on logging road FS 137 for .1 mile and bear right on logging road FS 5047 for .4 mile for view of the falls on your left. Easy, one mile round trip hike.

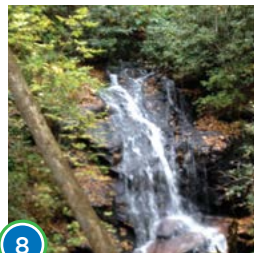
Slick Rock Falls

From the intersection of US 276, NC 280 and US 64 in Pisgah Forest head north on US 276 for 5.3 miles and bear left on FS 475 for 1.5 miles. Bear right on gravel logging road FS 475B for 1.1 miles to small parking area on the right. Enjoy the rewarding roadside view or take an easy, short hike for a closer look.

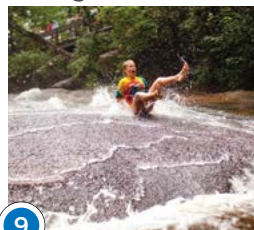
Falls on Log Hollow

From the intersection of US 276, NC 280 and US 64 in Pisgah Forest head north on US 276 for 10.2 miles and turn left onto gravel logging road FS 475B. Drive 1.6 miles to a large curve in road and park on the right side near Forest Management Sign. Do not block gate. Hike begins behind gate on the overgrown logging road. Cross two small bridges to view of falls on the right. Roundtrip is 1 mile.

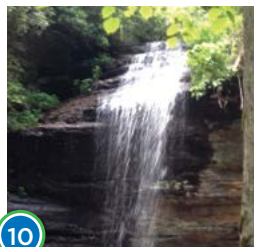
Sliding Rock Falls *

From the intersection of US 276, NC 280 and US 64 in Pisgah Forest head north on 276 for 7.9 miles to entrance on the left. Park and take short walk to a view. Bring your bathing suit and find out why it's named Sliding Rock! Between Memorial Day and Labor Day, a small parking fee is collected. Restrooms/changing rooms are also open during this time.

Moore Cove Falls *

From the intersection of US 276, NC 280 and US 64 in Pisgah Forest head north on US 276 for 6.7 miles to parking area on the right. Hike a footbridge over the Davidson River and follow a well-marked trail to the falls. An easy, round trip hike of 1.5 miles.

Looking Glass Falls *

From the intersection of US 276, NC 280 and US 64 in Pisgah Forest head north on US 276 for 5.6 miles to a long narrow parking area. Pull over here and take a short walk to the first viewing area, which is handicap accessible. For better viewing of this iconic waterfall, take the stairs down to a lower observation platform.

Twin Falls

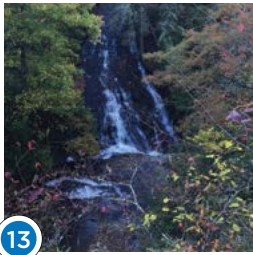

From the intersection of US 276, NC 280 and US 64 in Pisgah Forest, head north on US 276 for 2.2 miles. Turn right on Forest Service Road (FS) 477 and follow the gravel logging road 2.75 miles to a small parking pullout on right and Buckhorn Gap Trail. Hike Buckhorn Gap (orange blazes) for 1.7 miles to Twin Falls Trail on left. A beautiful, moderate hike of 4.4 miles, round trip.

WATERFALLS NEAR BREVARD

Batson Creek Falls/ Connetsee Falls

From the intersection of US 276 and US 64 in downtown Brevard, travel south on US 276 for 5.9 miles. Turn right into parking lot and walk a short, easy path to view Batson Creek Falls. You will also view the top of Connetsee Falls from a safe area. Handicap accessible. Easy access - and well worth the stop.

Key Falls

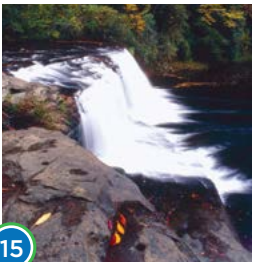

From the intersection of US 276 and US 64 (corner of Main and Broad) in downtown Brevard, travel US 64 East for .8 mile. Bear right on Old Hendersonville Hwy and drive 2.7 miles. Turn right onto Everett Road for .4 mile then turn right down Key Falls Inn driveway. Park at the end of driveway and hike short trail up to gravel road for viewing. This waterfall is on private property. Key Falls Inn very generously allows visitors.

WATERFALLS IN DUPONT STATE RECREATIONAL FOREST

Hooker Falls *

From the intersection of US 276 and US 64 downtown Brevard (corner of Main and Broad), travel south on US 276 for 11 miles. Turn left on Cascade Lake Rd and travel 2.5 miles. Turn right on Staton Rd. and travel 2.5 miles to Hooker Falls Access parking area on the left. Follow Hooker Falls Road .25 mile to a side viewing area. Walk another .1 mile down for a front view. If the weather is warm don't forget your suit - this is also a first rate swimming hole. The round trip hike is just under .5 mile.

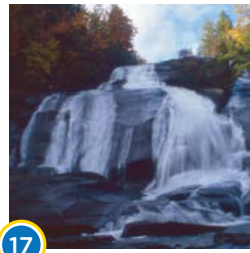
Triple Falls *

From the intersection of US 276 and US 64 in downtown Brevard (corner of Main and Broad), travel south on US 276 for 11 miles. Turn left on Cascade Lake Rd and travel 2.5 miles. Turn right on Staton Rd. and travel 2.5 miles to Hooker Falls Access parking area on the left. Cross the walking bridge and hike along the Little River to a right turn up a steep gravel trail. Hike is a beautiful, moderate 1.2 mile round trip with well marked trails.

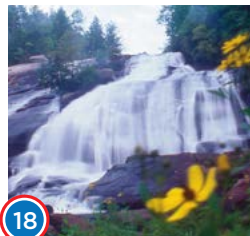
High Falls *

From the intersection of US 276 and US 64 in downtown Brevard (corner of Main and Broad) travel south on US 276 for 11 miles. Turn left on Cascade Lake Rd and travel 2.5 miles. Turn right on Staton Road and travel 1.5 miles to High Falls Access and Visitor Center on your right. Take the new walking trail paralleling Buck Forest gravel road to High Falls trail. High Falls is an easy scenic walk in the woods approximately, 1.6 miles roundtrip. This waterfall is one of Transylvania County's best!

Bridal Veil Falls

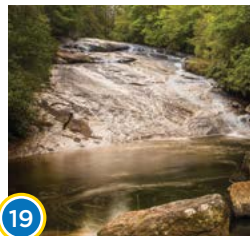

From the intersection of US 276 and US 64 in downtown Brevard (corner of Main and Broad), travel south on US 276 for 11 miles. Turn left on Cascade Lake Rd and travel 2.5 miles. Turn right on Staton Rd. and travel 1.5 miles to High Falls Access and Visitor Center on your right. Take the new walking trail paralleling Buck Forest gravel road to meet up with Buck Forest Rd.

Take short walk and cross the covered bridge. Turn right on Conservation Road. Walk approximately one mile and turn right on Bridal Veil Falls Road. Follow road for .5 miles to a single track trail for the viewing area. This is a fairly level, 4.5 mile round trip walk with well marked trails.

Wintergreen Falls

From the intersection of US 276 and US 64 in downtown Brevard (corner of Main and Broad), travel south on US 276 for 11 miles. Turn left on Cascade Lake Road and travel 2.5 miles. Turn right on Staton Road and travel 4.8 miles. Turn right on Sky Valley Road and travel .9 mile on pavement and another .8 on gravel. Turn right into Guion Farm access parking area. Hike Tarklin Branch to Wintergreen Falls

Trail. Looking for a picturesque waterfall that's a little off the beaten track? This is the one. A moderate 2.75 mile round trip ramble.

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Pisgah National Forest, DuPont State Recreational Forest and Gorges State Park all offer excellent waterfall and recreation information at their respective Ranger Stations or Visitor Centers:

DuPont State Recreational Forest

Start your DuPont waterfall adventure at the Aleen Steinberg Visitor Center. From the intersection US 276 and US 64 in downtown Brevard (corner of Main and Broad), travel south on US 276 for 11 miles. Turn left on Cascade Lake Rd and travel 2.5 miles. Turn right on Staton Rd. and travel 1.5 miles to the High Falls Access and Visitor Center.

Gorges State Park

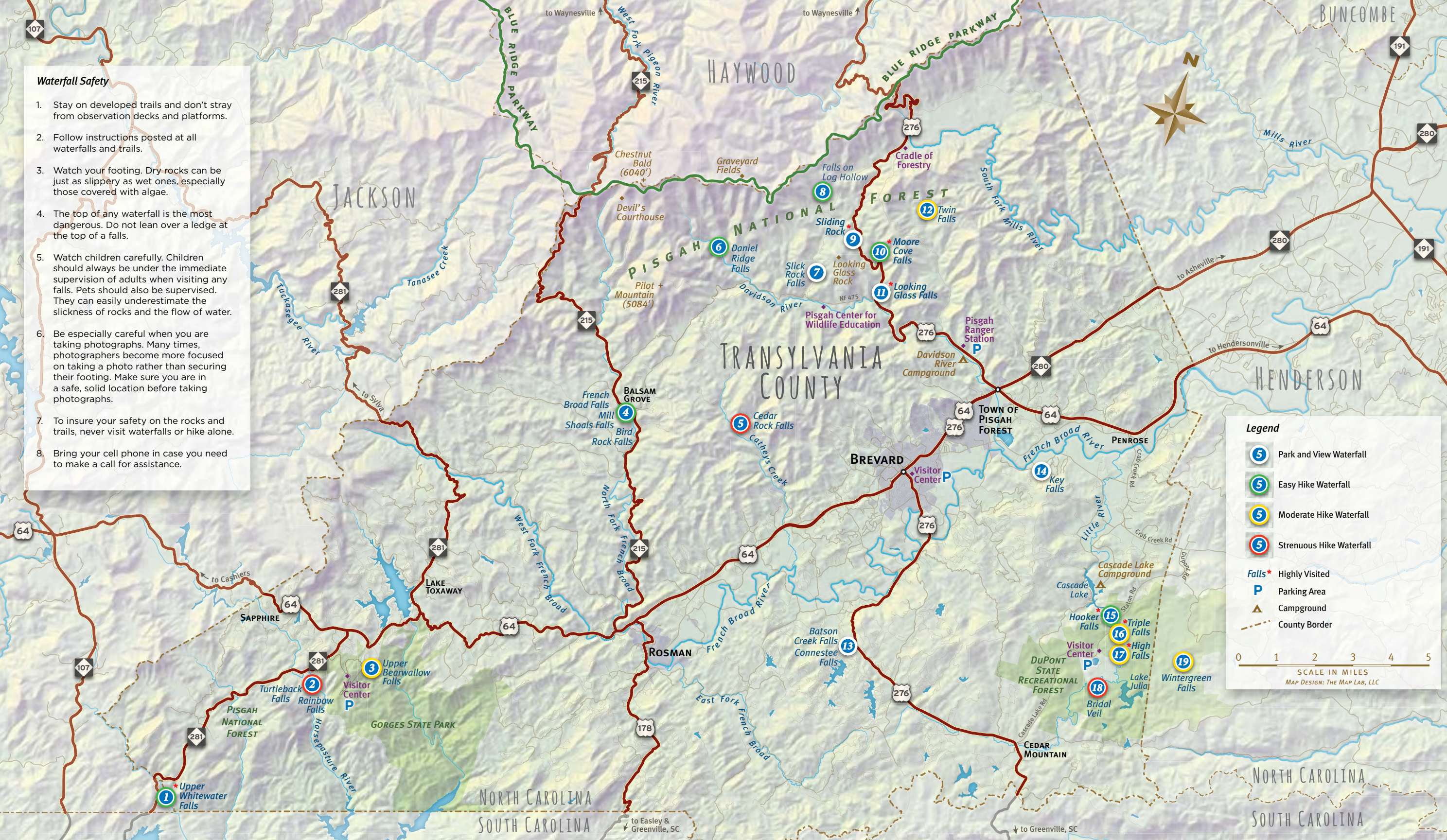
Gorges' new Visitor Center offers a great introduction to this remote and rugged park. From the intersection of US 276 and NC 64 in downtown Brevard (corner of Main and Broad), go west on US 64 for 18 miles. Turn left onto NC 281 and travel south for 1 mile. Turn left into main entrance for Gorges and follow paved road to the visitor center.

Pisgah National Forest

The volunteers and staff at the Ranger Station can direct you to Pisgah's many wonders. From the intersection US 276, NC 280 and US 64 in Pisgah Forest head north on US 276 for just under 2 miles. The Ranger Station is on your right.

Waterfall Safety

1. Stay on developed trails and don't stray from observation decks and platforms.
2. Follow instructions posted at all waterfalls and trails.
3. Watch your footing. Dry rocks can be just as slippery as wet ones, especially those covered with algae.
4. The top of any waterfall is the most dangerous. Do not lean over a ledge at the top of a falls.
5. Watch children carefully. Children should always be under the immediate supervision of adults when visiting any falls. Pets should also be supervised. They can easily underestimate the slickness of rocks and the flow of water.
6. Be especially careful when you are taking photographs. Many times, photographers become more focused on taking a photo rather than securing their footing. Make sure you are in a safe, solid location before taking photographs.
7. To insure your safety on the rocks and trails, never visit waterfalls or hike alone.
8. Bring your cell phone in case you need to make a call for assistance.
